



## Gardena Municipal Bus Lines

### Frequently Asked Questions

1. Which bus can I catch that will take me from Gardena to Bishop Montgomery High School? *Gardena #3*
2. How much is student bus fare? *\$0.70*
3. Will the bus's head sign display Bishop Montgomery H.S.? *Yes.*
4. Can I catch the Gardena Line 3 bus to Bishop Montgomery High School anywhere along the route? *Yes, you can board the #3 bus starting at 163<sup>rd</sup> & Vermont and at any stop along Redondo Beach Blvd up to the final boarding stop at 182nd and Hawthorne Blvd. Just make sure the head sign reads "3-Bishop Montgomery H.S."*
5. If the bus is full when it gets to my stop will you send out another bus? *We commit to monitoring the passenger loads to BMHS and will put additional buses in service if necessary.*
6. If I miss the #3 Bishop bus will another #3 Bishop come soon? *We will only put additional buses to BMHS if the one bus is over capacity.*
7. Will there be more than 1 bus to/from BMHS daily? *We will only put additional buses to/from BMHS if the one bus is over capacity.*
8. Can I catch the #3 bus in Compton and transfer to the #3 Bishop bus in Gardena? And if so, do I have to pay for a transfer? *Yes, you can catch the #3 bus in Compton and transfer to the #3 BMHS bus in Gardena without paying a transfer fee. You will need to tell the driver that you are a BMHS student and ask for an Intra-agency transfer. Give the transfer to the driver of the #3-BMHS bus.*
9. How much is a transfer if I need to transfer to a Torrance or MTA bus? *GMBL local transfer is \$0.40; Interagency transfer to Torrance is also \$0.40*
10. On late start days, when Bishop starts school at 8:45am, will there be a late bus? *No. Buses will run a regular normal schedule, arriving at 7:45am. However, there is an accommodation for early dismissals at 12:45pm on Fridays only.*
